

College Timetable For The Class of 2009

- August '08 Register if you need to take the SAT's
- September '08 Set up appointment with your school counselor to finalize your college list. Decide what schools you will apply to Early Action or Early decision. Set up interviews for schools. Visit colleges. See link: Guidelines for Completing College Applications when working on your applications.
- October '08 Make sure you have all your college applications. Final drafts of essay and activity resume are due. Early Action or Early Decision applications are due. Contact ETS: send scores to colleges. Give teachers your requests for recommendations. Forms available on: www.morriscatholic.org or in the guidance office.
- November '08 Finalize applications that you want to be out by Christmas.
"Mid-Year Reports section of the college applications must be turned in to the guidance office.
Check in the guidance office to see if the FAFSA forms are in.(Free Application For Student Aid)
- December '08 EA/ED responses should be sent out.
Rolling Admission application responses should be coming out.
- January '09 Submit your completed FAFSA as soon as possible after January 1st.
- May '09 Respond to college with your deposits.
Prepare for your AP Exams.
Complete the Senior Questionnaire. Form can be found on www.morriscatholic.org/academic/guidance/forms.
- June '09 Submit your request for final transcripts to be sent to the college of your choice
