COMMUNITY

Denville is a friendly, suburban town 35 miles west of New York City with a population of 16,000 people located in the center of Morris County.

SCHOOL

Morris Catholic is a coeducational, parochial, college preparatory school that enrolls approximately 500 students in grades 9-12.

ACCREDITATION

STUDENT BODY

Morris Catholic welcomes students from varied social and economic communities. It offers a diverse atmosphere in which to educate young men and women to grow through a knowledge of the love of Christ.

ADMISSION POLICY

All applicants for 9th grade must take the COOP Entrance Exam, submit middle school transcripts and recommendations and complete an application for admission. The Admissions Committee, directed by the Principal, reviews each applicant to determine admission status.

Transfer students must be interviewed by a member of the Admissions Committee who will interpret academic records and counselor recommendations from the sending school. A recommendation is presented to the Principal for admission determination.

FACULTY

Composed of religious and lay teachers of whom 70% have advanced degrees.

CURRICULUM

Morris Catholic offers a complete academic college preparatory program. Students are challenged in English, Mathematics, Science, History, Foreign Languages and Computer Science on the Honors and Advanced Placement levels.

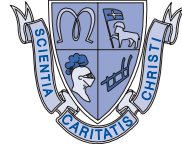
